Evelyn Brown of the Irvine Ranch Land Reserve Trust will provide an intriguing overview of the native birds and test your ability to distinguish the sounds. Arrive early with your lawn chairs and sing campfire songs with us!



Evelyn Brown is a Field Naturalist for the Irvine Ranch Land Reserve Trust. She leads tours and programs in both the inland and coastal areas of the Reserve. Before the Trust, she spent eight years with the City of Anaheim's Oak Canyon Nature Center as a naturalist and supervisor.



*There is a required a \$4 Park entrance fee per vehicle. Sale items related to this event will be available.

Note: The Interpretive Association will have wood available for sale if campfires are allowed. If in the 48 hours before the event, more than ¼ inch of rain falls, the event will be cancelled and refunds given. Campsites are first come, first served. We do require reservations and advance payment for the Camp Out. Space is limited.

In the morning, join us for a nature hike! Bring your binoculars and bird/animal guides to listen and identify some of nature's wonders.
