## Overnight Camp Out

Saturday Set Up: 4–6 PM through Sunday ~9 AM

Location: The State Park’s Group Campground

Individual Cost: \$ 10 per person\*

Group Costs: \$ 8 per person for groups of 4 or more\*

Web Reservations Required, space is limited.

Join us for an overnight adventure in the State Park to learn about the owls of Chino Hills State Park and to enjoy the yipping of coyotes in the distance. Camping reservations are required and can be made through our website. Campers must bring all of their own equipment and supplies. We highly recommend carpooling, arriving early to set up camp, and enjoying the sunset. We will camp at the Group Camp area. Note: There are no fires allowed.

\*The fee covers the cost to camp in the Park and enjoy apple cider and popcorn before the Campfire program.
